The essence of who you are and the tasks of conscious aging. Your personal conscious aging plan

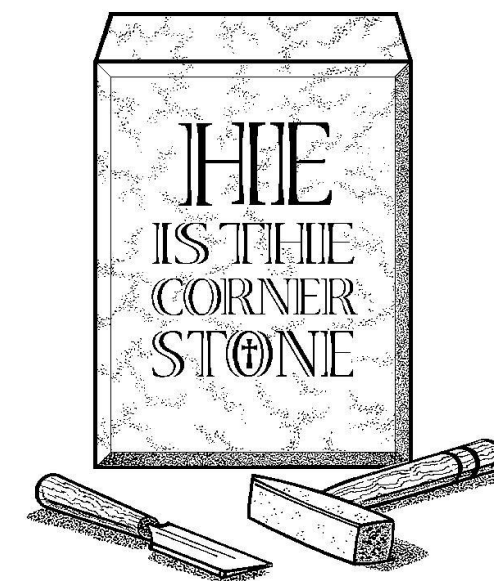
June 24<sup>th</sup> - Roads Not Yet Traveled
