**A Minute for Health Ministry  
Ronald McDonald HouseCharities**

Recycled beverage tabs help support your local Ronald McDonald House program, a temporary “home-away-from-home” for the families of seriously ill children being treated at nearby hospitals.

The American Legion Cone Post 386 is the collector of aluminum pull tabs for our areas for the Ronald McDonald House, Durham, NC. They collect the **tabs only** as they are cleaner and easier to collect in larger quantities than the whole cans. Tabs of a standard soda can are made of high quality, high-grade aluminum. You can also recycle tabs from soup and other aluminum cans. One way to know if the tab is aluminum is to take a magnet – if the tab sticks to the magnet, it is not aluminum.

Funds generated from recycling these aluminum tabs help to offset the Ronald McDonald House’s expenses.

It is a statewide program adopted six (6) years ago. In those six years the American Legion has **collected 97,006 lbs of aluminum tabs and given \$62,298.28 to the Ronald McDonald House of Durham.**

**Every penny** helps families stay at the House - **\$10.00 pays for one family for one night.**

The American Legion collects the aluminum tabs and turns them in three (3) times a year – February, June and October. They receive the going rate for aluminum, which changes as the demand changes, varying from rates of 23 to 52 cents per pound.

POP TAB FUN FACTS: Approx. one million pull tabs = 800 lbs

Approx. 1,430 pull tabs = one pound

Approx. 63,360 pull tabs = 1 mile

The Health Ministry Committee would like to make this one of our projects. To get this going we need everyone’s help. So please save your aluminum tabs and ask your friends, family, neighbors to do the same. If we help one family it will be worth it. There will be a Ronald McDonald House box in the hallway going to the fellowship hall for you to leave your tab collections.
